From the sequel: The Four Seasons of Kyoto Shin-Hanga Nishiki-e. Very beautiful and fresh proof bearing the artist's red stamp and signed in pencil. A rust spot in the sky. Ca. 1950. Tokuriki was born and raised in Kyoto. From his childhood, he was influenced by the local art scene. He was one of the leaders of Kyoto Sosaku Hanga although he also distinguished himself brilliantly in Shin Hanga. Graduating from the Kyoto School of Fine Arts and Crafts, he went on to study at the Kyoto Specialized School of Painting. After beginning his career in painting, he found his true vocation in woodblock printing and became enthusiastic about the revival of this technique in 20th-century Japanese art. His considerable influence inspired many artists. He founded his own publishing
