### Description

Imposing bronze sculpture representing a Native American chief - Signed Carl Kauba (1865-1922)  
Stunning and powerful bronze sculpture with polychrome patina representing a Native American chief in ceremonial dress, draped in a monumental feathered headdress and holding an ornamental shield. The dynamic attitude of the figure, the muscular modeling of the body and the meticulous details of the costume testify to remarkable craftsmanship and a deep interest in the indigenous cultures of North America. The piece bears the signature of Carl Kauba, an Austrian sculptor renowned for his depictions of scenes from the American West. Although Kauba probably never traveled to the United States, his works are imbued with a romantic exoticism nourished by the tales of conquest and Indian
