frame, ending in a red dot. This creates a contrast
with the red ball of color,
which makes the color, resembling blood,
simultaneously present inside and
outside the picture. The pencil figuration also has
an aura that extends beyond
the frame.

About the
artist

Ouhi Cha

studied painting at Chung-Ang University in
Seoul from 1964 to 1969. In 1977,
she traveled to Europe, first living in Paris, and
then, from 1981 on,
alternating between Berlin and Seoul. In addition
to painting and drawing, she
began producing lithographs and illustrating
volumes of poetry. In 1996, she
received a scholarship from the Senator of
Culture of Berlin, and in 2001, she
was awarded the Seok Ju Cultural Foundation Art
Prize. Her work, which combines
Korean calligraphic tradition with Western
modernity, has been exhibited
numerous times in Germany (Berlin, Düsseldorf,
and Dresden), South Korea (Seoul
and Busan), and Japan (Tokyo and Kyoto).
