Description

Flowers artwork, antique oil painting, proposed here is anoil painting on canvas from the end of the XIX Century and is dressed with a carved and lacquered wooden frame called Montparnasse. Rose flowers. It is a beautiful bouquet of cut Red and White Roses placed in a wicker basket. Old paintings on canvas, still life dated 1894 and signed lower right Pierre Bourgogne (1838-1904), french painter of flowers, fruit and still lifes. Pierre Bourgogne (1838-1904) was born in Paris and died in Sèvres (Hauts-de-Seine), a student of V. Galland, Ch. Polish and Lequien. He exhibited at the Paris Salon and then at the Salon des Artistes Français from 1869 to 1904 where he received an award in 1888. Then at the Universal Exhibition of 1889 he obtained a medal.
