Leopold Ziller was an Austrian painter known for his luminous landscapes, particularly his views of Venice and the Bosphorus in Constantinople, often compared to those of Felix Ziem. Influenced by classicism and romanticism such as Claude Lorrain and JMW Turner, Ziller captured these light-filled urban scenes. Visible at the Galerie Courcelles Antiquités, at 97 rue de Courcelles, in the 17th arrondissement of Paris.
