Description

Charcoal drawing of a centaur, mounted under Marie-Louise and framed. The frame includes a plaque bearing the artist's name, Eugène Fromentin. A red stamp is visible in the lower right part of the drawing; it was affixed during the Fromentin sale, where it appeared under lot number 421. On the back of the work are several labels that testify to its provenance: a label from the Adolphe Beugniet house (art dealer and framer), one from the Bernheim-Jeune gallery, as well as a last one from the Garde-Meuble Nortier. All of these elements contribute to attesting to the authenticity and the historical journey of the work. Good general condition nevertheless, some traces of wear on the frame.
