Alexandre Tahan took over the "boxes and
necessaries" company created by his father and
developed it with the production of boxes, liqueur
cellars and small precious pieces of furniture
(bonheur du jour, worker, desk) like Paul
Sormani. He then completely revolutionized the
organization of the company by separating the
factory and the store. Maison Tahan then became
prosperous, employing many workshops; it
