Armand Guéry (1853-1912) Washerwoman on the Suippe, 1906 oil on cardboard mounted on canvas 64x130cm Important wooden frame and gilded stucco 92x158cm (very good condition) Armand Guéry, born March 4, 1853 in Reims and died May 25, 1912 in Gueux (Marne), is a French painter. Guéry is the landscaper of the Champagne sky; he is also the striking evocative of Alpine landscapes. He began in 1882 and since then he has won prizes at the Salon des Artistes Français of 1885, 1891, 1894, and at the Universal Exhibition of 1900. The Museum of Fine Arts in Reims has several paintings by this painter.
