



Lime Gourd, Papua New Guinea

Description

This gourd, formerly used to hold lime, is made from an engraved and polished coconut shell. The white lime, applied in the engravings, reveals the geometric patterns. A stopper, ingeniously woven from yellow orchid fibres and brown plants, encloses the substance. Papua New Guinea, mid-20th century.
