on the left, we can recognize
a professional and an upper body, while the figure
on the right also has
anatomical features. With this reinforcement, we
can clearly recognize a human
figure in the middle. The people on the right are
clearly a couple, and the
person on the left has turned away from them.
Encouraged by these clues, our
imagination begins to form a network of
relationships between the three
figures. However, we are unable to resolve it,
which activates our imagination
even more.
