Provenance: Succession Claude de Marteau The Dvaravati style developed in the Mon kingdom of Dvaravati, which flourished in the central region of present-day Thailand from the 6th to the 11th century, its main Dvaravati cities included U Thong, Nakhon Pathom, Phong Tuk, Si Thep, Khu Bua and Si Mahosot. The style is inspired by Gupta and post-Gupta art of India, particularly in the modeling of bodies and faces. This style reflects the physical characteristics of the Mon people, with broad faces and noses, full lips, and
