## Description

Articulated chatelaine in the 18th century style formed of several cartouches in multi-tone gold and centered with chiseled oval medallions. Chiseled country trophies, including gardener's tools, hat, doves, dog, quiver, basket and garlands of flowers and leaves give this ensemble a hymn to love and nature. On either side of the central cartouche, two chains reproducing the flower motif end with a winding key and a blank seal. Central hook for the missing watch. A gold chain and safety pin, vermeil back clasp. In its case from Molgatini Frères in Orléans, with the lid stamped with a marquis' crown above the number SV (worn). Weight: 40 gr Goldsmith's hallmark: Auguste Perette, active in Paris between 1856 and 1910. Hallmark: eagle's head Hallmark: boar's
