Paolo Sala, "Marina Ligure," oil on canvas, signed, Early 20th centuryOil painting on canvas, signed at lower rightMeasurements: Framed H 83 x W 99 / Canvas H 64 x W 77This painting by Paolo Sala depicts a Ligurian marina, and captures a calm and bright atmosphere with a sailboat in the foreground. The boat, with a large ochre-colored sail, is reflected in the calm waters, where reflections create a soft and striking play of colors. The sea is calm, with blue and turquoise hues fading to white, and stretching to the horizon, where other boats with light-colored sails can be seen silhouetted against an azure sky. The sky features large, fluffy white clouds that seem to float above the sea, accentuating the peaceful atmosphere of the scene. The mountains or hills in the distance, with their bluish outlines,

create depth and define the Ligurian coast, while the few brushstrokes on the horizon line suggest houses or small buildings, giving a touch of humanity to the landscape. Sala's technique is delicate, with broad, soft brushstrokes that emphasize the reflections and transparency of the water. The light and bright colors, together with the balanced composition, evoke a feeling of serenity and quietness typical of Italian seaside resorts. The artist's signature in the lower right confirms the authenticity of the work, making this painting a visual testimony to the beauty of the Ligurian coast.
