Covered vase or tripod incense burner in Satsuma earthenware with enamel decoration in reserve depicting a woman and child, with fan, and cherry blossoms on the back Lid with lion on ball and also lion handles Rests on three feet with chimera decoration Signature ideogram under the base Small accidents restorations Period: Meiji period (1868-1912) Dimensions: height 40 cm, width 12 cm, weight 1.6 kg Born in the 16th century, Satsuma designates polychrome earthenware or porcelain decorated with gilded designs. After being presented at the 1867 World's Fair in Paris, this porcelain proved to be a popular export good to Europe.
