HURARD Joseph (1887-1956) "Fishermen at La Pointe du Brescon, aux Martigues" Oil on canvas, Signed lower right Titled on the back by the artist: "N°37 - Martigues, the port in the sun", Beautiful work by the Avignon painter Joseph Hurard which depicts fishermen in a tartane at the Pointe du Brescon in Martigues. The artist used a brightly colored palette and played on contrasts to represent the nuances of color on a summer day. A student of Pierre Grivolas and Charles Vionnet in Avignon, Joseph Hurard exhibited numerous landscapes at the Salon des Indépendants from 1908 to 1914, notably of Avignon and Villeneuve-les-Avignon. He joined the Group of Thirteen founded by Clément Brun. After the First World War, he exhibited in galleries in Marseille. In 1932, he settled in Martigues. site he Dealer
