Beautiful and large original lithograph on full-page vellum paper by Alain Bonnefoit (1937, -), signed in pencil lower left by the artist. Alain Bonnefoit, born in Paris in 1937, is a French painter, lithographer, designer and sculptor. He studied art in Paris and Brussels. He studied sculpture with Antoniucci Volti. He moved towards representations of nudes that he created using the Japanese technique of "sumi-e", drawn in Indian ink where a single freehand line is used for an entire drawing. The bodies are embellished thanks to a rich and luminous palette with a preference for the colors of the Mediterranean. Alain Bonnefoit is a major artist of his generation.
