Description

Magnificent and rare box in guilloché and enameled solid silver. The box's lid features a checkerboard pattern consisting of squares alternating with two types of guilloché work, covered with a very warm yellow-brown enamel. Each square is surrounded by a silver border. Between these squares is a network of black enamel embellished with silver flakes. The rim is also encircled with a black enamel border. The handle is guilloché with wavelets and yellow-brown enamel, with black enamel borders. The bottom of the box is guilloché with a circular wavelet pattern. The interior is silver-gilt. The box is hallmarked: Boar's head for solid silver since 1838. The silversmith's mark is very small and therefore difficult to read: EP with a mark similar to that of Puiforcat. It's most likely
