Legitimist plate representing "Mgr Le Duc de Bordeaux" Born on September 29, 1820, child bust, holding a rattle in his hand. Plant frieze on the border. The plate does not bear any mark. Henri Charles Ferdinand Marie dieudonné d'Artois, Duke of Bordeaux, better known under the courtesy title of Count of Chambord was born in Paris, Palais des Tuilleries on September 29, 1820 and died on August 24, 1883 at the castle of Frohsdorf, Austria. Posthumous son of the Duke of Berry and grandson of Charles X, he is the last representative of the elder and French branch of the House of Bourbon and pretender to the crown of France in 1844 under the name of Henri V.
