Doulton Lambeth faience stamp, dated 1877, monogram MB for Mary Butterson (attributed). Pansu vase with small neck. Height: 35.5 cm Circumference: 54.5 cm Base diameter: 10 cm. The name Doulton Lambeth is widely known to collectors of British ceramics - it refers to the vases, cups, bowls and jugs decorated by craftsmen such as George Tinworth, Eliza Simmance, Edith Lupton and others for the pioneering Royal Doulton art pottery workshop, which was established in the London suburb of Lambeth in 1871.

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
