Panoramic view of the battlefield: a general blows a bugle as the cavalry prepares to charge. This work is typical of Palamedes' 17th-century battle scenes. Despite his death at the age of 33, Palamedes left behind a substantial body of work centering on the recurring conflict between the Netherlands and the English, with scenes of cavalry advances, skirmishes, and encampments.
