



Important Porcelain From The Cantonese Qing Dynasty, Late 19th Century, Qianlong Mark, Palace



Description

An important Chinese porcelain plate made in Canton in the late 19th century. This charger measures 80 centimeters in height including the base and measures 62.5 centimeters in diameter. Apocryphal Qianlong mark on the back, in fact high quality objects from the end of the 19th century often bear this apocryphal mark in reference to the reign of the great emperor Qianlong (1735-1796), a period of reference and apogee of Chinese art in terms of creativity and quality. Our charger is a relatively rare model, a similar example bearing a coat of arms in the center was sold on 13-12-2011 for EUR7,500 excluding fees at Christie's (see the last photo) and without the base. Interesting decorations composed of a frieze of butterflies, fruits and flowers on the rim and three large cartouches
