Armchair with beech cushion, molded and carved with a bouquet of flowers. The arms are slightly whip-shaped, and the rounded belt, called a cushion, has a lively shape, it rests on arched feet. Louis XV period This seat is stamped MICHARD This seat is in perfect condition Beautiful silk in perfect condition. In addition to its stamp, which is quite rare on the market, this seat is very interesting in terms of the shape of the rounded seat, also uncommon, and the aesthetics of the flowers. Claude Etienne MICHARD (1732-1794) Parisian carpenter, he was established on rue Sainte Foy. His seats were always very carefully executed, as illustrated by the very spirited sculpture on the back of this seat. He specialized in the interpretation of the Transition style, mixing Louis XV forms with more neoclassical
