Decoration of blue pastoral scene, work circa 1730
Grooved rim
Bearing the mark R on the reverse, directed by the Master faience maker Hess Van Frederick who in February 1719 lived at the Scheepmackerij and was the husband of Elizabeth van Nedervvaert.
Hess Van Frederick took over the factory at the Rose around 1732 which he directed for several years.
