Kang Boke has beautiful scarlet flowers in early spring, but there are also the small crimson Yodo Boke, the red Shu Boke, the large pale pink Canton Boke, the white Sarasa Boke with a red background and the Changchun Boke which blooms all year round. Boke originated in China, and many of those planted in gardens today are of the Chinese variety, but the Boke found in the mountains and fields of Japan is Kusaboke.
