



Pair Of Louis XV Candlesticks With Coats Of Arms, Silver-plated Metal, Christofle, 19th Century



Description

Pair of Louis XV style candlesticks in finely chiseled silver-plated metal, decorated with a coat of arms with a chevron shield and three stars on the foot, straight socket mounted on a moving baluster shaft, round base with contours and moldings, hallmark of Maison Christofle*, from the second half of the 19th century. These candlesticks are in good condition, they have their bobèches. Good quality, they are very decorative. Hallmarked on the foot. Please note: some dirt, scratches and wear from time, see photos. *Christofle is a French goldsmith brand, founded in 1830 by Charles Christofle. Its master goldsmith hallmarks were registered in 1845, the date of the first "silver-plated goldsmith" factory. At the end of the 19th century, Maison Christofle now produced silver-plated metal objects.
