PASTOUR Louis (1876-1948) "Mist at sunrise, Cannes, 1941" Oil on cardboard, Signed lower left (hidden by the frame), Titled, countersigned and dated on the back by the artist: "Mist at sunrise, Lousi Pastour, 8-(19)41, Beautiful poetic work by the Cannes painter, Louis Pastour, which depicts a fisherman in his boat in the morning mist in the bay of Cannes. The artist uses a palette of soft colors, perfectly achieving the effect of the mist. The large red sail sharp as a wing, its typical boats, the light of the sky, the sea... immerse us in the air of old Cannes from the Belle Époque. Worker by day and student in the evening classes at the School of Decorative Arts in the city of Nice then Paris, he exhibited for the first time at the age of 45. Painter of light with a total mastery of colors, Louis Pastour uses the knife technique to bring his works to life. Recognized by critics as a poet painter because of the names of poems they give to his works: Fête de soleil, Reflets d'or, Gloire au matin ...
