to have never attended any school and it is very

likely that his father taught him the trade. The

family arrived in Paris in the years 1907/1908.

Roger Favin exhibited for the first time at the

Salon of the Société Nationale des Beaux-Arts in

1928. He presented 3 busts there including that of

his mother. He participated regularly. He became

an associate member of the Société nationale des

Beaux-Arts in 1932 and a member in 1933. He
