This work seems to have been created by the artist, according to the notes on the back of the panel, in 1926 in Entrevaux. The large red sail sharp as a wing, its typical boats, the light of the sky, of the sea... immerse us in the air of old Cannes from the belle époque. Worker by day and student in the evening classes at the School of Decorative Arts in Nice and then Paris, he exhibited for the first time at the age of 45. In
