Empire period portico clock circa 1810, architecture in white marble and blue turquin marble accompanied by a very sober ornamentation in mercury-gilded bronze with very finely chiseled gold. Row of pearls, rosettes, laurel wreath, vases and a sun pendulum. Domed dial in white enamel accompanied by gilded and finely worked hands, underlined by a guilloche bezel set with a domed glass.

Stamped on the dial below the number VI by the enameler, dial manufacturer, "DUBUISSON", listed in the Tardy.
