Pair of rock crystal parrot candelabras Europe, late 18th century
Elegant pair of finely carved and engraved rock crystal candelabras, each depicting a parrot perched on a round white marble base.
Finely chiseled gilt bronze mount, with two twisted light arms decorated with acanthus leaves.
o Total height: 31 cm

Nota bene: These two examples are extremely rare: they correspond to the taste for exoticism that was very popular at the end of the 18th century. Similar forms can be found in the archives of the famous Parisian merchants-merciers - true distributors of exceptional objects at the time. The latter did not manufacture anything themselves, but selected, assembled and enriched objects from elsewhere (crystal, lacquer, porcelain, etc.) for a prestigious
