powerful gray-blue tones Massive trees, painted with broad, dark brushstrokes A solitary male figure, lower right, providing a discreet human presence The brushstroke is broad, expressive, and structured. The whole evokes the spirit of Raoul Dufy, Othon Friesz or Marquet, in a direct language, without mannerism. It is a spontaneous, spirited work, with well-placed colors. About Georges de Sonneville A Bordeaux painter trained at the Beaux-Arts, Georges de Sonneville distinguished himself with a late Fauvist style and a frank look at daily life: ports, circus scenes, cabarets, markets, etc. His works, still affordable, are increasingly sought after for their vitality and regional charm.
