of the painting. The Bosisio family was one of the
most important and noble in

Monza and the subject of the portrait was part of
it. The gentleman is

portrayed standing, looking to the right, wearing
typical clothes of the time.

Next to him you can see an armchair and a small
desk on which a book and a

letter are placed. With his right hand he holds the
glove on the table, while

with his left he holds his hat, just below him the
sword tied to his belt is
