EndFragment:0000001767 Born in Burgundy, this earthenware factory began by making tiles then, after its acquisition by the Charbonnier brothers in 1868, it moved towards the production of finer ceramics and then towards the production of slips demanded by the great hours of gastronomy and decoration, fond of realistic and richly colored objects, at the end of the century. Oriented towards the implementation of presentation pieces such as asparagus services and other table-pictures, the earthenware factory created this set of three superimposed plates, intended to offer gastronomes, seafood lovers, thirty oysters on a single display, with the
