About Monbro Aîné Monbro Aîné was the trading name of a prestigious 19th century French furniture company, renowned for its high-end pieces in the Louis XVI, Empire and Napoleon III styles. The term 'Aîné' (meaning 'the elder') was used to distinguish the eldest brother who ran the family workshop. The Monbro family, of German origin,

Their company, Monbro Aîné et Cie, gained international renown for the exceptional quality of its furniture and participated in major exhibitions, such as the Great Exhibition in London (1851) and the Universal Exhibition in Paris (1855), where it received awards and recognition. It catered to: The French nobility The upper middle class of the Second Empire Senior civil servants Aristocratic and royal households Monbro Aîné's furniture is renowned for its exceptional use of fine woods, richly detailed gilt bronze mounts, and historical styles executed with academic precision. Today, their signed works are highly sought after by collectors and museums.
