Painter of lively landscapes, seascapes. Orientalist. He was a student at the Academy of Fine Arts in Königsberg in the former East Prussia. Then he settled in Munich in 1891. - He devoted to the landscapes of Iceland, Normandy, the coasts of Portugal, sites of Tenerife, curiosities of Venice, Istanbul and the Bosphorus; which suggests that he traveled a lot. In 1907, in a residence in Frankfurt am Main, he
