With its sleek glass top and industrial black enameled steel base, the LC6 embodies the machine-age aesthetics and rational functionality that defined modernist architecture and design. The frame, inspired by airplane fuselages, is both bold and minimal, emphasizing structural clarity and elegance. The clear glass top appears to float, supported by discreet rubber shock absorbers that enhance the table's visual lightness while ensuring stability.
