Pierre Boncompain, born in 1938 in Valence, is a painter trained at the Arts Décoratifs and the Beaux-Arts in Paris. Heir to the post-Nabian tradition, he developed a personal language from the 1960s onwards, made up of simple lines, colorful harmonies, and intimate scenes, influenced by Matisse and Bonnard.
