The drawing is accompanied by letterhead from landscape architect Joseph Linossier in Lyon La Demi-Lune (Rhône). It is written: "Painting representing the: Park of the Château de l'Étang de la ville, Ville de Bagnolet" and "Painting produced between 1873 and 1876", followed by a list of the works of the J. Linossier company: "Park of the Château de Vaurenard (69), Park of Lacroix Laval (69), Château de Lizérieux (07), Villa Marius Bulet (Lyon), Manor of Châteaueux Ste Catherine (69), Château la Bretonnière (26)". The land and the pond of Bagnolet were purchased in 1873 by the rentier Charles Frédéric Bühler who had the castle built there and the park laid out. Bühler died in 1933
