*Paul Le More (act.1863-1914): (Ec fr) Couture student. He made his debut at the Salon of 1863. Member of the French Artists Association since 1883. His works are mentioned as "Les Trois Amis" and "Le Gué". He painted many portraits of racehorses, prized by amateurs and collectors.
