Description

These two painted porcelain plates represent a beautiful example of decorative art linked to the House of Savoy and the historical context of the first decades of the 20th century, linked to the royal wedding between Italy and Montenegro. One plate depicts the coat of arms of the House of Savoy, one of the oldest ruling dynasties in Europe, which governed Italy from 1861 to 1946. At the base of the coat of arms is the date 1915, a symbolic year because it represents the year of Italy's entry into the First World War The central coat of arms with the white cross on a red background is the traditional one of the House of Savoy with the motto "Fert" which was adopted as the official symbol of the Kingdom of Italy.
