Important polychrome terracotta statue representing ALBA.ABLA AND ANTAR, THE ARABIAN LEGEND OF IMPOSSIBLE LOVE.In the desert of Saudi Arabia, one of the most famous legends of Arabic literature: the story of Abla and Antar. This epic, which spans the centuries, is not only a love story à la Romeo and Juliet, it is a symbol of the fight against prejudice. Far from idealized love tales, the story of Antar and Abla is a fight against social norms and inequalities that takes place in the dunes of the Al Qassim desert.
