### Description

This exquisite round guéridon was crafted in France in the 19th century, inspired by the graceful lines and rich ornamentation of the Louis XV style. Designed as an elegant accent or side table, it features a beautifully inlaid marquetry top in a diamond parquet motif, framed by a delicate gilt bronze gallery with finely chased detail. The shaped apron incorporates the same marquetry work and discreetly conceals a smoothly sliding drawer -- ideal for storing small items while preserving the table's refined silhouette. Four cabriole legs support the piece, each adorned with finely cast gilt bronze appliqué in the form of floral garlands, terminating in ornate sabots. This table was likely produced by a skilled ébéniste working in the tradition of 18th century furniture but adapted for
