### Description

A fine early 19th-century porcelain jug produced by the Rockingham Ceramic Factory, Swinton, England, around 1830. The jug features a four-lobed form with molded Rococo-style scrollwork, richly gilded and accented in yellow over a grey-glazed ground with visible craquelure. The scalloped rim is enameled with floral sprays on both sides. The loop handle is foliate and fully gilt.

The underside is marked with model number "8376" in puce enamel. This number corresponds to a jug
