

Reboul-Hector-Berlioz was part of the French
selection for the Arts Olympiad organized by the
Lise Cormery Gallery for the French National
Olympic and Sports Committee in 1991 and 1992
in Paris, on the occasion of the 1992 Winter
Olympics. This followed the Seoul Arts
Olympiad, where the city founded a painting
museum and an open-air museum of monumental
sculptures with international artists invited to
