Description

Mahogany and mahogany veneer filing cabinet, Louis Philippe period, circa 1830-1840. This notary, bailiff or lawyer's cabinet opens on the front with 2 bays of 8 cardboard drawers, covered in green leather and gilded with small iron, locked by two small doors on each side, allowing the confidentiality of files to be maintained. It ends with a doucine Gilt bronze trim Professional furniture which was given the name "cartonnier" Our furniture has kept a good state of conservation and can be used as before, since the current folders containing the files have the same dimensions as at the beginning of the 19th century This piece of furniture can find its place anywhere where storage is needed, especially since it is very elegant
