The title is on a label glued to the support, under the drawing (the upper right corner of the label is missing): "Premier essai qu'offrit à l'amour mater[nel], D'un fils reconnaissance le talent naturel". Funerary monument bearing the name "Kunstort" (= place of art or artistic site in German).
