Meslier was established rue de l'Arbre sec in 1812-and remained active in 1819 He bought his whites and applied decorations to them, constituting real tin paintings. Ours are particularly well painted with finesse and rendering. Height 28.5 cm. The base 9X9 cm. Original mounting.
