The conical end is in chased silver, decorated with beaded rings and twisted threads. The fineness of the work on the horn suggests a high-quality handcrafted piece, probably intended for a notable or for ceremonial use.Remarks:Rare collector's item, highly sought after by lovers of tribal art, ethnography or Asian curiosities.A fine example of traditional Laotian
