Materials: Finely carved horn and silver  
Condition: Very good condition, natural patina of the horn, no visible restoration.  
Description: Superb Laotian tobacco pipe, composed of a carved horn body decorated with stylized plant motifs, evoking the traditional symbols of Buddhist and animist iconography of Laos. The conical end is in chased silver, decorated with beaded rings and twisted threads. The fineness of the work on the horn suggests a high-quality handcrafted piece, probably intended for a notable or for ceremonial use.  
Remarks: Rare collector's item, highly sought after by lovers of tribal art, ethnography or Asian curiosities. A fine example of traditional Laotian
