Sorry, no airmail export for this, LOTO DAUPHIN game, France 18th century, with 10 boards resting on 4 turned feet, numbered from 1 to 90, each slot pierced to plant a fichet, in a pink cardboard box, two levels containing 12 double baskets of bone fichets in 4 colors, yellow, white, blue and red, including a dozen dolphin-shaped fichets. Large white wooden box to store everything, used condition. . Dimensions: 26cm x 23cm. Good condition, fichets are superb and numerous, intended for 10 players. Paper show normal traces of wear, one or two boards a little warped. Flaw We are missing the numbered tokens, originally made of turned wood and paper. Sotheby's, (thanks for this text): Dauphin lotto was marketed from 1775 by table maker Vaugeois to overcome the monotony of classic
